

Instruction for use

Intended Use

The colonoscopy pants used for medical purposes in clinical facilities to extend the hygienic life of existing Scrubs of healthcare personnel in hospital and operating room environments and to prevent contamination from microorganisms such as viruses and bacteria and body fluids. This product is disposable and it prevents bacterial and viral transfer between the medical staff and the patient, reducing the risk of contamination and infection between the patient and the medical staff during the operation and patient visit.

2. Design

Endoaccess GmbH supplies colonoscopy pants in 2 different sizes (L and XL) applicable for most patients. Information on the range of sizes available may be obtained directly from us.

3. Before use

The user should study these instructions carefully before using the colonoscopy pants. In addition, the user must inspect the item for defects and damages after removing it from the pack. Do not use it in case of damage.

The colonoscopy pants are supplied non-sterile by Endoaccess GmbH. The colonoscopy pants must be inspected before use. Only undamaged items must be used! Colonoscopy pants must be used only once!

Check before use

Open the packaging and check for damages. Do not use the item if damaged. Contact Endoaccess or your distributor for exchange.

Before the operation

The patient is dressed in the disposable colonoscopy pants prior to the operation to avoid inconveniences for the patient or delay of the procedure.
